JETTY JUMPING BANNED



BY-LAW NO. 7 – FORESHORE

Prevents a person from:

- Jumping or diving from a jetty;
- Tying or affixing any watercraft to a jetty; or
- After being requested to leave a jetty by an authorized officer, to come back onto the jetty within 24 hours of the request.

The reasons for banning jetty jumping are:

- **Protect jetty jumpers from self inflicted permanent disabling injuries**
- **Public safety on our foreshores**
- **Allowing people to use the beach, knowing it is safe to do so**
- **It is a local community matter, to be policed and controlled by local government.**
