Your minimum Certificate III qualification in a relevant area (eg Civil, Carpentry/ Joinery, Electro Technology, Cabinet Making, Mechanical, Paining/Decorating, Signs/Graphics, Horticulture etc) is essential as is a Workzone Traffic Management Accreditation, industry White Card and MR drivers licence.

Your demonstrated experience in a relevant area and in the safe use and maintenance of equipment, machinery and tools is critical to the success of the role. A basic understanding of computers and database management and experience in using corporate digital applications including the *TechnologyOne* suite of applications will be highly regarded.

This is a full-time position, working 76 hours per fortnight. Hours of work may be varied in summer and winter and depending on responsibilities assigned within the Rapid Response/City Cleansing team. You may be required to work a series of flexible shifts with some commencing at 5.00 am, and days that may range from 8 to 10 hour shifts. Your work may be team based or isolated working with heavy plant (eg sweepers, beach cleaner). Therefore your flexibility and willingness to be rotated to various tasks is essential.
