

Inflatable Amusement Device Fact Sheet

If a member of the public wishes to use an Inflatable Amusement Device such as a bouncy castle in a reserve or park within the City of Holdfast bay as part of a private function, the following information should be advised:

Service Provider:

- A reputable company that is registered with Safe Work SA must be used. We advise a copy of their Safe Work SA registration be demonstrated to the person engaging the operator's services.

Insurance:

- Council requires the operator has Public Liability Insurance for \$20,000,000 (twenty million dollars) and a copy of their Certificate of Currency be provided.

Where:

- Council does not approve the use of inflatable amusement devices on the beach.
- Use on the Foreshore and sea front locations will only be permitted within organised events, not private functions.
- Use on reserves and parks that are located away from the foreshore/sea front are permitted, weather permitting.

Supervision:

- Members of the public are to be reminded that all amusement devices/rides – no matter what type – must have a trained supervisor/operator/attendant at all times when the device/ride is in use on Council land.

Guidelines:

Compliance:

- It is the member of the public's responsibility to be aware of and comply with any Legislation, Council By-Law, guideline or standard relating to Amusement Structures.
