Kobo eReader, Glo, Touch (For Kobo Vox, refer Android Tablet info below)	No (these Kobo models do not have browser)	Yes. Installation of Adobe Digital Editions to PC or Mac required. Once eBooks are downloaded to your computer, you are req'd to transfer them from computer to your Kobo
Sony Reader	No (does not have browser)	Yes. Installation of Adobe Digital Editions to PC or Mac is required (except for the Reader WiFi model). You will also need to install additional Sony Reader software to your Sony Reader via your PC/Mac
iPad/iPad Mini/iPhone/iPod Touch	Yes, compatible with Safari browser, use latest iOS	Yes. Install the OverDrive Media Console App for iPad/iPhone – found in App Store
Apple Mac	Yes, compatible with Safari browser	Yes. Installation of Adobe Digital Editions to your Mac required
Android Tablet (e.g. Kindle Fire, Kobo Vox, Samsung Galaxy Tab, Asus Nexus 7)	Yes, compatible with modern browsers on tablet. Chrome browser recommended	Yes. Install the OverDrive Media Console App for Android to your tablet – found in the Google Play Store (also known as 'Android Market')
Android Smartphone (e.g. Samsung Galaxy phones, HTC)	Yes, compatible with modern browsers on phone. Chrome browser recommended	Yes. Install the OverDrive Media Console App for Android to your phone – found in the Google Play Store (also known as 'Android Market')
Windows Surface Tablet/ Windows Phone	Yes, compatible with modern browsers on tablet. Chrome browser recommended	Yes. For Windows Surface Tablet, install OverDrive Media Console App from the Windows Store. For Windows Phone, install OverDrive Media Console from www.windowsphone.com
Windows PC/laptop	Yes, compatible with modern browsers (Explorer 10 or Chrome browsers recommended). If have Explorer 7/8/9, install 'Google Chrome Frame' plug-in for Explorer when prompted	Yes. Installation of Adobe Digital Editions required. You can then read on your PC/laptop. Having Adobe Digital Editions installed will also enable you to transfer your books to compatible eReaders or devices

Our **OverDrive** service is **FREE** (unlike many other eBooks & Audiobooks you buy online, where often you'll pay more than \$10 for a title).

Other great benefits

- You can access the service 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- There's no need to visit the library to return titles – downloaded titles with a fixed lending period expire automatically on your device at the end of the lending period (which means no late fees!)

Some things you need to know

- **Kindle eReader & some other eReaders are NOT compatible with this service**
- Installation of software may be required – please follow instructions in help guides
- You'll need your library card and PIN as well as access to the internet to download eBooks & Audiobooks to your device
- For some devices, not all titles may be compatible

Borrowing information

- Customers can borrow 6 eBook/Audiobook titles in total. Loan times can be selected as 7, 14 or 21 days through settings
- Customers can place holds on 6 titles that are checked out and can receive an email notification once a title is ready. You will have 3 days to start accessing a title once you have been notified by email that your hold is now available

Audiobook access

Note: Audiobooks can be very large files e.g. 500mb. Consider this in relation to your Internet or phone plan's data download allowance. Audiobooks can only be played on device with audio playback ability (note: some eReaders will not have this). **OverDrive** Audiobooks come in two formats, MP3 & WMA. Not all devices can play both formats. View **OverDrive's** compatibility guide at: www.overdrive.com/resources/drc

For **Android, iPad, iPhone & Windows Phone/Surface Tablet** install the **Overdrive Media Console app** to browse & access MP3 Audiobooks wirelessly using the app.

For many other mobile devices, you should install **Overdrive Media Console for Windows** on a PC/Mac, then download an Audiobook to your PC/Mac, then transfer it to your mobile device.

eBooks - access the way that's best for you

OverDrive gives you 2 options to access eBooks:

- **OverDrive Read** - if you prefer to simply open an eBook using an internet browser and start reading. No need to install 'download software' or 'app'
- **Install 'download software' or app** - if you prefer to download an eBook to your device before reading. Additional 'download software' or 'app' to be installed

OUR TOP TIPS:

1. If you prefer the **Install 'download software' or app** option, you'll need an 'Adobe ID'. Visit <https://www.adobe.com/au> & click "Sign In" then click "Get an Adobe ID". You will need your email address and to create a password.
2. If you're also planning to use your PC/Mac in conjunction with this **Install** option, then it's likely you'll also need to install **Adobe Digital Editions** software. Visit www.adobe.com/au/products/digital-editions/download.html ...and install this software on PC/Mac before browsing our OverDrive catalogue for the first time
