

# 3 HOUR PARKING LIMIT ZONES

Application Form

**2021 - 2022 Financial Year**

1st July 2021 to 30th June 2022

To ensure that residents have reasonable access to parking for their premises, and retailers are not disadvantaged by all day parking occupying potential customer parking areas, Council has established three (3) hour time limit zones.

Three hour time limit zones have been created within the area bounded by Anzac Highway and Jetty Road, and Brighton Road to Colley Terrace. Both sides of Anzac Highway west of Brighton Road, Marion Street, Maturin Road, Olive Street and a portion of Kent Street are also included. The three hour zone applies seven days per week from 9am to 6pm to all previously unrestricted areas within the defined area, and does not affect other existing parking restrictions.

**Residents who have insufficient off street parking for their vehicles may apply for a parking permit that will enable all day parking.**

Retailers and employees within the central shopping precinct are encouraged to park alternatively in the paid car parking areas, or to utilise other on and off street parking options.

On the next page you will find the conditions applicable to the Three Hour Exemption Permit, and a permit application form.

Payment can be made at 24 Jetty Road Brighton or The Glenelg Library, 2 Colley Terrace Glenelg.

## 3P EXEMPTION PERMIT CONDITIONS

- 1. THE PERMIT MUST BE DISPLAYED ON THE LEFT HAND SIDE OF THE VEHICLE DASHBOARD OR WINDSCREEN SO AS TO BE CLEARLY AND COMPLETELY VISIBLE FROM OUTSIDE THE VEHICLE** - tickets issued where a permit is not displayed will not be withdrawn.
- Issue of permits is subject payment of a \$147.00 fee per permit, which is applicable from date of receipt of application until expiry, which is the 30th June each year. The fee is not refundable if the applicant ceases to reside at the address contained in the application.
- The applicant is responsible for proving occupancy of the property shown on the application and proving ownership of the vehicle which will display the permit.
- Issue of a permit is subject to there being insufficient off street parking available at the applicant's address and the applicant allowing Council officers access to the property to inspect it for availability of parking space (if required).
- A \$15.00 administration fee will apply for the reissue of any lost or damaged permit.
- The permit only allows a vehicle to be parked in excess of the time limit in 3P (three hour time limit) zones in the suburb of the applicant's property, it does not allow exemption from any other parking restrictions or requirements
- The permit does not allow the vehicle displaying it to remain stationary in the same position for a period in excess of 24 consecutive hours.
- The permit applies only to vehicles of persons residing or staying at the applicant's property, as shown on the permit application form.
- Breach of these conditions may result in cancellation of the permit.
- Council may change the conditions applicable to permits with reasonable notice.
